

Boothwyn Farms 1913, McCaysville – This is a section of ‘Boothwyn Farms’ shows the area from what is now known as Chichester Avenue down to the East Branch of Naamans Creek Road.

Roads shown in pink (such as Meetinghouse and McCay) are unpaved. Roads in gray are improved or paved roads. Meetinghouse Road was not paved until the mid 1920’s. It is interesting to know that the road names have changed over the years. In 1913, the section of Meetinghouse Road between what is now Chichester Ave. and Naamans Creek Road was actually called Chichester Ave. What is now Chichester Avenue was called Concord Road (from Meetinghouse toward Concord) and was Marcus Hook Road (From Meetinghouse toward Marcus Hook). Standing at the current crossroads of Chichester and Meetinghouse you would see four different roads in the four directions!
