

Boothwyn Farms 1913, near Naamans Creek – This section of ‘Boothwyn Farms’ shows the area just past the East branch of Naamans Creek up to Naamans Creek Road. Also shown are Boothwyn Avenue, Mill Road and Central Avenue, which were all unpaved in 1913. Several of these roads never did get paved and disappeared off of the plan later on. Central Avenue, of course exists (note: the Galbreath house at the corner) but never made it all the way through as show. Only the ends of Boothwyn Avenue are around today. The one end off of Naamans Creek Road is Rockhurst and the other end just recently was renamed Boothwyn Avenue again after being know as Bethel Avenue for many years – this section is off of Chichester Avenue right after the train bridge.
