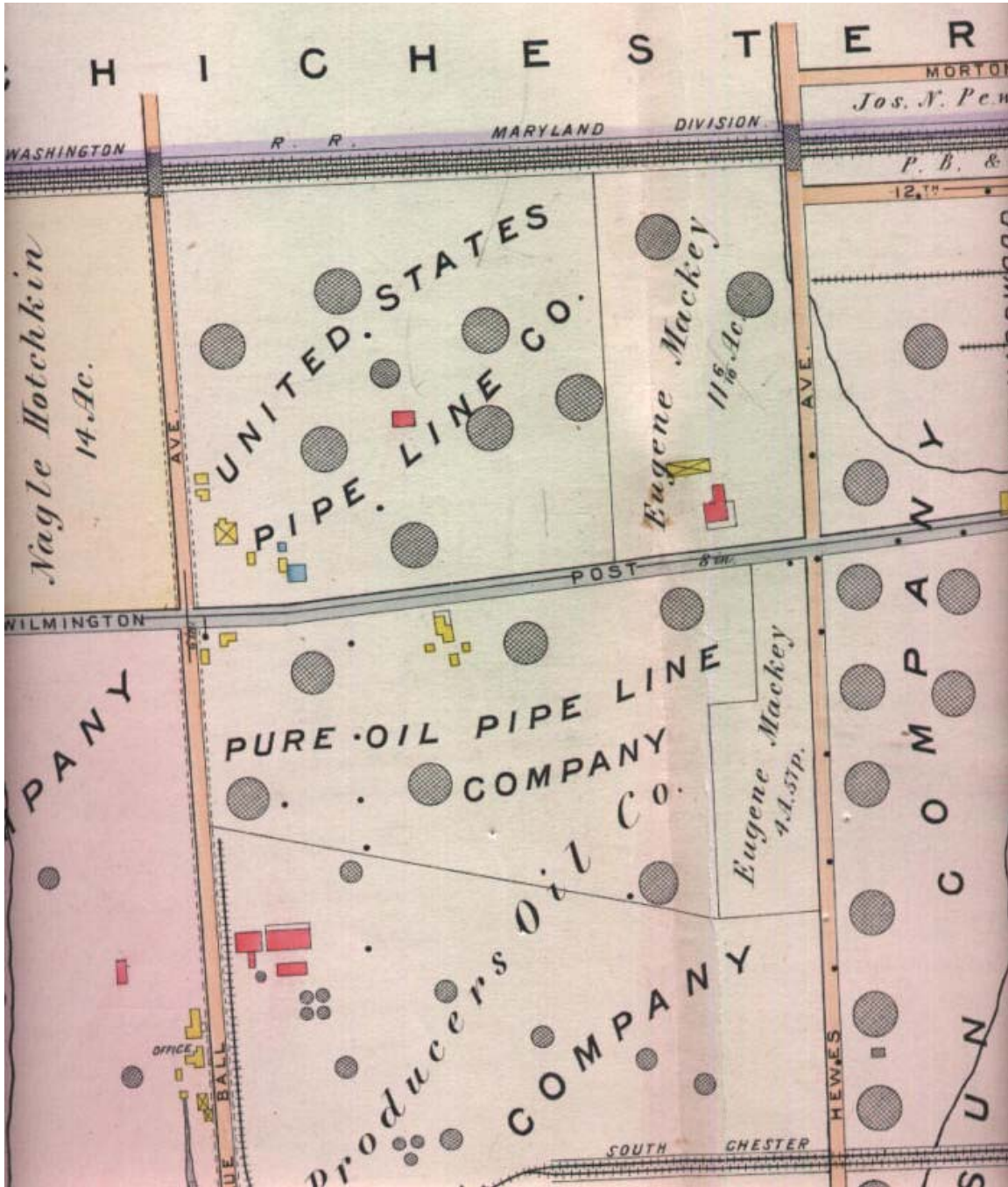


Pure Oil, 1913 – This section of the 1913 map shows some of the Pure Oil Company’s land and tanks. Also seen here are Blue Ball and Hewes Avenues crossing Post Road and the tracks of the PB&W train line, which made its stop at Linwood Station. Both Blue Ball and Hewes were unpaved, dirt roads at that time, where Post Road (represented in gray) was an improved or paved road.



Another section of the 1913 map shows the corner of Marcus Hook at the Delaware State Line. A picture of a box of Four Hundred Oil by the Pure Oil Company is also shown.
